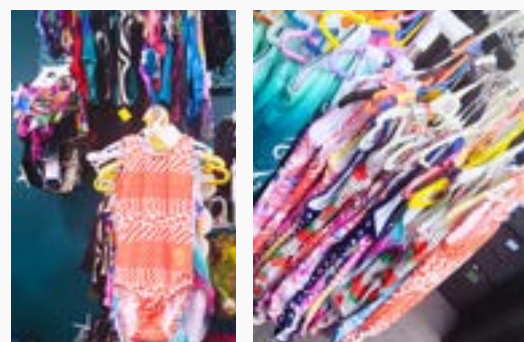
Cadbury Chocolate Fundraiser
