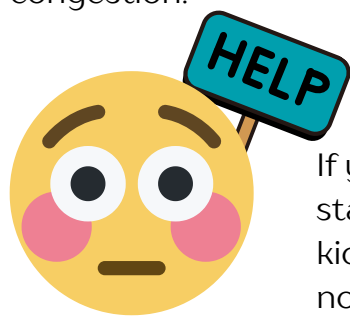

We are very fortunate to have our large purpose-built facility and boast a large membership of over 600 gymnasts. However our reception walkway space is limited and this can easily become clogged up before the start of classes. We've implemented a few things to help such as designated shoes areas and queueing posts at the office window.

We also ask that parents/carers move along through the walkway to free up space for kids trying to get to classes. We have an awesome upstairs viewing area with ample seating for you to stay and watch your child. Similar to schools who do to stop, drop, go – we're asking parents to 'Kiss & Go or Sit & Stay' to help with the congestion.



If your child is feeling anxious and struggles to go the floor, our admin staff or coaches can help – please ask us to assist. We know that once kids make the first brave step, they happily join classes and have fun in no time!

A FEW HOUSEKEEPING ITEMS

- Please arrive on time for classes.
- No school uniforms to be worn while training on the floor.
- Children to be seated upstairs – no running/jumping on the seating.
- Please keep children off the fencing and gates. We have had multiple panels broken from children climbing/ hanging from the fencing.
- Remember to bring hair ties. Hair should be tied up in a bun.
- The drive through is for quick drop offs and pick ups. Please don't sit in the drive through if your child is not ready to come out yet. This also serves as our exit so must be kept clear to prevent congestion in the car park.
- Please ensure you collect/drop off your children on time. It is not admin or our coaches responsibility to watch children before/after their class time.
- Check lost property bin or the office for missing items. Lost property is cleared out at the end of each month.
